### Recommendation:

That the Board of Deferred Compensation Administration receive and file the following report regarding the special election for the Pensions Representative seat on the Board of Deferred Compensation Administration.

### Discussion:

On November 5, 2009, the Fire/Police Pensions seat on the Board of Deferred Compensation Administration became vacant. The Board's Election Policy provides that in the event of a vacancy occurring in an elected seat a special election must be held within 90 days of the vacancy. Staff, in coordination with the City Clerk Election Division, conducted the necessary election within the required time frame. Attached are the election results, indicating that John R. Mumma won the seat with 98.47% of the votes cast.

Mr. Mumma is expected to attend the Board's February 16 meeting date. Staff will provide an orientation to Mr. Mumma prior to that meeting.




