

Counter Activity Employee Benefits Division






Accrued Leave Activity

Staff has compiled the following results of Accrued Leave enrollment for the month of May 2012. During the month of May, 53 participants elected to enroll in Accrued Leave and \$1,368,635 was contributed into the Plan from their Accrued Leave payouts. The number of participants was more than double the average number of accrued leave enrollments.









Hardship Activity

Staff has compiled the following results of hardship processing with Great-West for the month of May 2012. During the month of May, 46 hardship cases were submitted to Great-West. There were 39 cases approved, 2 cases denied, and 5 cases pending further documentation. The dollar amount for hardships withdrawn from the plan in May 2012 was approximately \$364,663.






Loan Activity

Staff has compiled the following results of new loans acquired for the month of May 2012. During the month of May, 496 participants elected to obtain a new loan and \$5,776,341 was withdrawn from the Plan for their loan payouts.




Deferral Tracking

Staff has compiled the following results of bi-weekly deferral cash flows for the month of May 2012 for the City of Los Angeles and Department of Water and Power. During the month of May, the City and Department of Water and Power deferred \$20,714,134 into the Deferred Compensation Plan. This compares to \$14,206,681 in May 2011, however, it should be noted that there were three pay days in May 2012.



Roth Accounts

The Roth deferral option was made available to participants starting July 2011, with actual deferrals being made by August 2011. For the month of May 2012, there were 56 new Roth accounts established. There are currently a total of 945 Roth accounts. This constitutes a **3.3**% participation rate of the 28,674 employees contributing to the plan¹. The chart below illustrates the number of new Roth deferral accounts since August.
