
Fund Changes Implementation – As a reminder, effective April 28, 2008, the Plan will eliminate Fidelity Magellan Fund, Lotsoff Small-Cap Equity Fund and the Capital Guardian U.S. Equity Fund due to long-term under performance. These funds will accept contributions and transfers until the termination date of April 28, 2008. Any remaining contribution allocations and asset balances will be mapped accordingly:



These changes were previously communicated to all Plan participants. A follow-up communication will be issued to participants by mid-March, reminding everyone of the aforementioned changes or the alternative choice of the Self-Directed Brokerage Option for Magellan Fund participants.

Investment Survey –Great-West will mail the Board's recently approved Investments survey March 26th to all Plan participants. The results of the survey are expected to be presented to the Board within approximately two months of the issue date.

Hardships - Staff has compiled the following results of hardship processing with Great-West for the month of February 2008. These charts represent the results and basis for each submitted hardship withdrawal between February 1, 2008 through February 29, 2008. Twenty-one hardship cases were submitted to Great-West through February 2008. Fourteen cases were approved, three denied, and four were pending further documentation.
